
How to Flush Aquatica Whirlpool System





- Fill the bath with warm water to a level 2-3" above the highest jets, or just leave water in the bathtub after using it.
- Add 2 tablespoons of a low-foaming dishwashing liquid and 1 cup of white vinegar. Alternatively, you can just use powdered dish detergent.
- Run the whirlpool for approximately 10 minutes. Then shut off the whirlpool and drain the water.
- Refill the bathtub (just cold water is fine this time). Run each hydromassage pump (each zone) for 5 more minutes to flush the system.

- Drain the tub and rinse baths surfaces with water.
- If you want a really deep cleaning, you can gently brush the jets with a bottle brush or a toothbrush and a nonabrasive microfiber cloth.
- If there's still dirt around the jet housing, try using dental floss to get behind them.
- Flush your whirlpool system at least once a month or more, depending upon usage.



Important

Success with cleaners and procedures is dependent upon such factors like the water hardness and temperature, using the exact measurement of ingredients, changes in cleaning formulas and the condition of the bathtub being cleaned. Since there are variations within these factors, Aquatica cannot guarantee the effectiveness of the formula described above.
